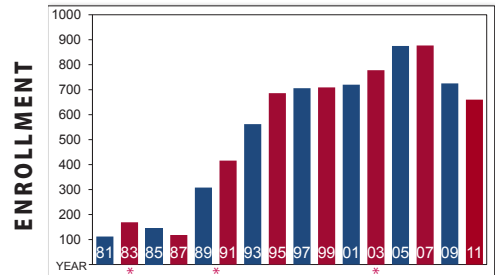
ORGANIZATION

DENOMINATIONS

Students attend over 100 different churches in the area. Interdenominational chapel services are held weekly on campus for the students and staff.

ADMISSIONS

Admission is selective. Students are evaluated on the basis of their transcripts, test scores, recommendations, and a personal interview. Santiam Christian does not discriminate on the basis of race, national or ethnic origin.

GRADUATES

Over 1600 students have graduated from Santiam Christian High School. Approximately 92% of the graduating seniors in 2011 are now attending colleges and universities, and were offered over \$4 million in scholarship dollars.

FINANCES

The 2011-12 operational budget is \$3.7 million. Approximately 13% of the budget is supplemented with outside income. Financial Aid is provided to 27% of the students.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

SAT scores for college-bound seniors:

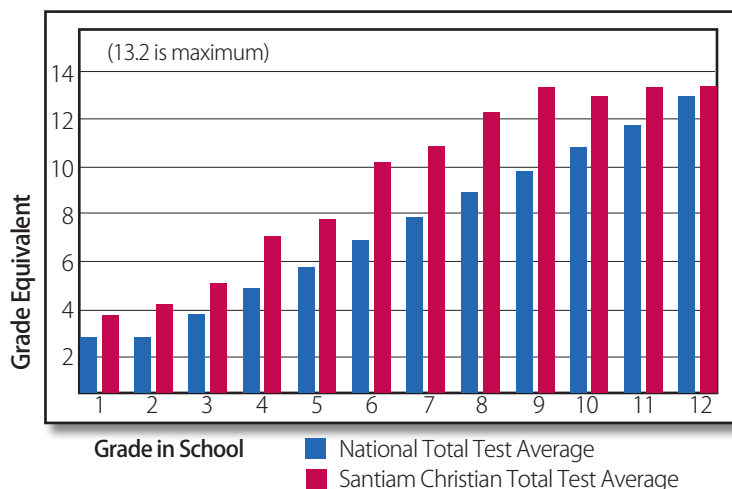
The class average for 10-11 was 144 points above the national average, and 104 points above the state.

Stanford Achievement Test Scores:

Average score is two years and one month above the national norms. Average percentile rank of 79.2%.*

statement of faith

WE BELIEVE the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (II Tim. 3:16, II Pet. 1:21).
