ADMISSION APPLICATION (Grades PreK-6th)

The primary purpose of Santiam Christian School is to assist parents in the Christian training of their children by providing a Christ-centered academic environment that encourages the development of a Christian world-view emphasizing academic excellence, Christian character, responsible citizenship, and service to others.

Thank you for your interest in Santiam Christian Schools. The application process can be completed by following the steps listed below.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Complete and return all attached forms to the above address.
2. A **non-refundable** \$75.00 Application Fee must accompany this application. Previously accepted and/or enrolled students need to complete the application process but should include only a \$25.00 Re-Testing Fee.
3. Each new applicant is required to *include* the following information with each application.

Preschool. Complete pages 2-6 and sign the Preschool Requirements Form - Page 9

Kindergarten. . . . Complete pages 2-6 (No references required)

Grades 1-6. Complete pages 2-6

Include a copy of his/her most recent report card and any available standardized test scores;
Two (2) Reference Forms (School - page 7, Character - page 8)

All Applicants, Grades PreK - 6th must print and complete the Oregon Certificate of Immunization Form available by copying this address into your internet browser:

4. **PreK-6:** All students will be evaluated to determine proper placement.
5. A personal family interview is required for new students. An appointment for this interview will not be scheduled until the completed application is received. ***Please note: Admission to Santiam Christian is selective. Students are evaluated on the basis of their transcripts, test scores, references, and interview.***
6. When the student is notified of acceptance, the payment of their Registration Fee will confirm their desire for admission. ***The student is not officially enrolled until the Registration Fee is paid.***
7. Mid-year applicants are handled on a *space available basis*.
8. Beginning April 1, new students will be accepted for the following school year from the pool of available candidates on an optimum student and space available basis.

PARENTAL COVENANT

Student's Full Name _____

Santiam Christian School's educational mission and Biblical role is to work in partnership with the home to provide Christian education designed to mold students to become Christ-like. On occasion this cooperation between the school and home may become difficult or strained. It may be that the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home may even be in opposition to the Biblical lifestyle that the school teaches. To avoid such situations, the school requires parents enrolling their children, or to maintain enrollment, to affirmatively support and cooperate with the school. **No student will be accepted into the school unless their parents sign, without any reservations, the agreement written below:**

As parents/guardian, I/we have read and do hereby acknowledge and understand that the following are working presuppositions by which Santiam Christian School is organized and operated:

1. I agree to support the school with my prayers and with a positive attitude. Complaints or negative comments will be shared only with the teacher, administrator, or person involved and not with my child or other people, following the Matthew 18 principle.
2. Although children of many Christian denominations make up the Santiam Christian School student body, each student (and parent) enters with the awareness that all teaching will be based upon the Santiam Christian Schools' Statement of Faith.
3. Santiam Christian School accepts the doctrine of "in loco parentis" (or in the place of the parents). We emphatically view the school, home, and local church as a partnership with its primary function of assisting the parents in fulfilling their responsibility to "train up their children in the way they are to go." (Prov. 22:6) I/We understand that this includes permission: a) to discipline as deemed wise and expedient for my child; b) to counsel my child Biblically; c) to be counseled Biblically when matters of my child's welfare arise. (Prov. 13:24; 19:18; 29:15, 17; Eph. 6:1-2; Heb. 12:6).
4. We pledge our fullest cooperation to keep doctrinal controversy and denominationalism out of the school at all times. (Rom. 13:8-10; I Cor. 12:12-14; 13:1-13; Gal. 5:13-15, 25-26).
5. If our son/daughter is involved in any disciplinary action, or should become involved in any trouble with other students, or should a misunderstanding arise between my student and the teacher, we will endeavor to settle any grievances quickly at the lowest level and according to Scriptural principles (Matt. 18, Gal. 6).
6. Assessments will be made to cover damage to school property (including breakage of windows, abuse of books, etc.)
7. A child who persists in undesirable conduct or attitude will not be permitted to remain in school to harm others by his influence. I/We further understand that the standards of the school do not tolerate profanity or obscenity by word or action, disrespect to school personnel, or abuse of building facilities.
8. We agree to pay tuition according to the schedule or to other arrangements that shall be made. I/We understand that report cards may be withheld if required payments are not made or arranged for. I/We also understand that if my account is 60 days past due, and no arrangements have been made, my child will no longer be able to attend Santiam Christian.
9. To help my child with homework when necessary and cooperate with the academic and spiritual goals of the school.
10. I understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that my actions as an individual or parent do not support the ministry, or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the home and school working together, the school has the right to refuse admission of a new applicant, or to discontinue enrollment of a current student. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, sexual immorality, homosexual sexual orientation, or inability to support the moral principles of the school.
