The Santiam Christian FFA Chapter will be sending five members to Indianapolis as they vie for national honors in TWO different career development events this week.

Gracie Krahn will be competing in the employment skills event. Employment skills is one of 25 career/leadership development event areas, covering jobs skills in everything from communications to mechanics. This event is designed to recognize outstanding FFA members for their ability to prepare and interview for real-world employment opportunities. Part of the preparation includes creating a cover letter, resume and completing a job application. Participants also show their ability to think on their feet through a networking activity. This event helps students develop the abilities to think critically, communicate clearly and perform effectively in a competitive job market.

Aubrielle Carter, Brooklyn Kuhn, Krisarah Nygren, and Cole Setniker will vie for national honors in the area of milk quality and products.
