Monday and Tuesday, students are signing in to each of their Google Classrooms and working on the things the teachers have posted there. Be careful to observe due dates and times. If you have problems with anything, please email the teacher.

Beginning this Wednesday, April 1, students will have regular, scheduled Zoom video calls as part of the school day. Each day, Wednesday through Friday, the day will start at 8:30 with Homeroom/Small Group teacher on a Zoom call. On Wednesday, students will continue with Zoom calls for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th period classes. On Thursday, students will follow Homeroom/Small Group with 5th, 6th, and 7th period classes. On Friday, students will follow Homeroom/Small Group with Chapel. Each day, students will also continue to work from Google Classroom.

## AP CLASSES & EXAMS
