With schools closed only one week prior to the Oregon FFA State Convention, SC FFA Members who had qualified to compete at the state level were left unsure of what would happen next. The past two weeks, Santiam Christian FFA competed remotely in multiple State Career Development Events. Here are the highlights:

- * Zavi Cristosomo – State Finalist in Beginning Public Speaking with his speech titled “Immigration Reform in Agriculture.”
- * Addie Wickliffe – State Finalist in Sophomore Public Speaking with her speech titled “The Hemp Propelled Gold Rush in Oregon.”
- * Devin Premsingh – State Finalist in Extemporaneous Public Speaking.



In addition, Gracie Krahn was one of only a handful of students from Oregon to receive a National FFA Scholarship. Gracie also received the highest award given to an FFA member in their respective state associations – Oregon FFA Star State Farmer. This incredible achievement, awarded to only one individual annually each year from the entire state, allows Gracie to advance to the national competition. Gracie will represent Oregon this fall at the National FFA Convention as she vies for the National Star Farmer Award.
