**THE OSAA CUP IS COMING HOME!**

Of the 36 3A schools in Oregon, Santiam Christian is #1! Santiam Christian has won the OSAA Cup, formerly The Oregonian Cup, ten times before. For the past nine years we've been in the top five every year usually within just a few points. We're thrilled to receive this top honor again this year! The OSAA Cup is a recognition of overall excellence. It evaluates every school in the state based on, not only athletic performance, but in a variety of other activities as well. It takes into account the overall percentage of students who participate in extra-curricular activities and looks at the grade point average of each of those who participate. It also looks at sportsmanship, as well as win-loss ratios. For every year since this award started in 1999, Santiam Christian's students have ranked in the top five of the state for schools our size.



It might sound like we're tooting our own horn, and we are a bit, but the real stars of this award are our students. This is their award! It is based 100% on their achievement and motivation to be the best they can be, in the classroom and in their chosen activities.
