### **RETURN TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION**

Elementary students are returning to full time in-person instruction as of January 4. Junior high and high school will return to school for 2 days of on-site instruction (January 6-7) this week while continuing on Zoom on the other days. Junior High and High School will return to 4 day/week instruction (Monday-Thursday) on Monday, January 11. JH/HS Chapel will continue to be online on Fridays. See the email from your school's principal for more information.

## Requirements Regarding COVID Protocols:

We are continuing to follow our state's guidelines for schools.

- \* Masks are required at all times on campus.
- \* If you have traveled out of state, the Oregon Health Authority recommends a 14-day quarantine before returning to work or school. You can read more about that here.
- \* Students who are exposed to a positive COVID-19 case <u>must</u> quarantine for 10-14 days after the last exposure. The length of time depends on a number of factors, so please let us know at the school office and we will help you determine what's needed.
- \* Please also notify the school office if your student tests positive for COVID-19 or has been exposed to a positive case. If outbreaks of COVID-19 occur among our student body and faculty, we would need to quarantine groups; having correct information about exposure and testing helps us determine quarantine periods, minimize the impact across campus, and coordinate appropriately with our local health authorities.
- \* Students who are ill with COVID-like symptoms should not come to school. The primary symptoms that definitely preclude coming to school include fever, cough, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, and loss of taste or smell. Students who have other symptoms of illness such as sore throat, fatigue, body ache, vomiting, or diarrhea must also stay home as these can be other symptoms of COVID or other communicable diseases.
- \* In order to enable continuing attendance in classes regardless of quarantines, we will continue to offer simultaneous remote instruction whenever we are "on-campus."


### **PSAT RESCHEDULED FOR JANUARY**


