High School/Junior High Student Covenant

Santiam Christian Schools (SCS) exists to assist parents in the Christian training of their children by providing a Christ-centered, learning environment that encourages the development of a Christian worldview emphasizing academic excellence, Christian character, responsible citizenship and selfless service to others. In short, SCS is not merely a private school, but a Christian school.

To support the school's mission and our focus on Godly Character, Christlike Leadership, and Christian Community students must indicate agreement, abide by and support each of the following points to attend Santiam Christian High School/Santiam Christian Junior High.

As a supportive student who has chosen to attend Santiam Christian School, I have read, acknowledge, understand, and agree to abide by the following statements:

1. I agree to support SCS with my prayers and with a positive attitude. Complaints or concerns will only be shared with the teacher, administrator, or person involved and not with my friends, other people, or other students and I will calmly and patiently resolve all disagreements by following the Matthew 18 principle.
2. I have read the Santiam Christian Parent/Student Handbook and agree to abide by all guidelines for student conduct as presented in the handbook.
3. I pledge to work with faculty, staff, and other students with a positive attitude. I promise to support accountability, responsibility, and uphold the policies governing life in the community of SCS as published in the school handbook throughout the 2021-2022 school year.
4. The SCS student body is comprised of students from many Christian denominations. I acknowledge and accept that all teaching will be based upon Santiam Christian School's Statement of Faith. I pledge my complete cooperation to refrain from promoting doctrinal controversy and keep denominationalism out of the school. (Rom. 13:8-10; I Cor. 12:12-14; 13:1-13; Gal. 5:13-15, 25-26).
5. I understand that if I am involved in any disciplinary action or should become involved in a difficulty with other students, or should a misunderstanding arise between a teacher and me, I will endeavor to settle any grievances quickly, at the lowest level and according to scriptural principles (Matt. 18, Gal. 6).
6. I understand that a student who persists in conduct or attitude that is inconsistent and incompatible with school policies and the school's code of conduct will not be permitted to remain in school.

7. I understand that if at any time the school determines, at its own discretion, that my actions as an individual do not support the ministry of SCS or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the mission and purpose of the school, SCS has the right to discontinue my enrollment.

8. As Santiam Christian School, we affirm that we remain committed to upholding the published statement of faith, operating under the leadership of our school board, and diligently pursuing education and support for each of our students that develops and builds Godly Christian, Christlike Leadership, and Christian Community. We will apply the guidelines in the student handbook to all students in a fair and consistent manner.
